



PAPUA NEW GUINEA IMMIGRATION AND CITIZENSHIP SERVICE AUTHORITY

Dear Foxtrot Resident

As you are aware, the Manus Regional Processing Centre (MRPC) is closing, at the direction of the Prime Minister of Papua New Guinea, no later than 31 October 2017.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that from **26 July 2017**, the accommodation you have been afforded by the Government of Papua New Guinea in the Foxtrot compound within the Manus Regional Process Centre will cease.

For residents who have been determined to be a refugee you have been afforded by the Government of Papua New Guinea a new residence at East Lorengau Refugee Transit Centre (ELRTC) which you should make arrangement to move to.

Alternatively, if you elect not to go to the ELRTC today you can relocate temporarily to accommodation in Delta and Oscar compounds within the MRPC. However, you will have to relocate in the imminent future to the ELRTC as the phased shut down of the MRPC continues.

For residents who have been determined to be a non-refugee you have been temporarily afforded by the Government of Papua New Guinea a location in Mike compound within the MRPC.

The ceasing of water, power and cleaning services within Foxtrot is imminent.

Residents who elect to remain in Foxtrot compound upon water, power and cleaning services are ceased are personally liable for any risk associated with residing in or entering Foxtrot compound.

All residents are required to move effective immediately.

Should you not move, you may be in violation of PNG law. Attempt to occupy without consent State property is also subject to legal action. Please note that any non-compliance and potentially illegal activity will be reported to the Royal PNG Constabulary.

Moving to the ELRTC will not affect your resettlement options.
